PUBLIC NOTICE TO MODIFY A UPDES PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO MODIFY A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT, SECTION 19-5-104(9) AND 107(2), UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO THE UPDES PERMIT AND THE FACT SHEET STATEMENT OF BASIS (INCLUDING TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303(D) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA)].

BACKGROUND

Bear River City permit modification is to add three new discharge points. 001D is located at latitude 41.601299° and longitude 112.139789°. This discharge point is to a retention basin for land disposal. 002 located at latitude 41.600978° and longitude 112.139184° discharge point of the bottom drain of retention basin flows into a ditch tributary to the Malad River. 003 located at latitude 41.600978° and longitude 112.138783° the discharge is an emergency overflow spillway from the retention basin and discharges to a tributary of the Malad River. In November 2015, the City completed construction of a 12 million gallon land application reservoir. The reservoir is located on private property with an agreement of first right to purchase with the city. The reservoir is fenced and will be signed before beginning operation.
