Treatment Variance Request for Wastes Containing PCBs

The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control has received a site-specific treatment variance request submitted by EnergySolutions LLC for the Mixed Waste Facility. EnergySolutions proposes to treat waste containing hazardous contaminants and PCBs and dispose of the treated residual in the Clive Facility Mixed Waste Landfill Cell. The variance would allow disposal without the PCB contaminants meeting the Universal Treatment Standards.

The public comment period to receive comments on the Treatment Variance Request will commence on May 3, 2016 and end on June 3, 2016. A public hearing on this issue will be held upon request.
