PUBLIC NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF A UPDES PERMIT

**PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE**

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO TERMINATE A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER QUALITY ACT, SECTION 19-5-104 AND 107, UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO UPDES PERMIT AND THE STATEMENT OF BASIS (INCLUDING THE TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303 (d) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA).

**BACKGROUND**

Weir Specialty Pumps has requested to terminate their UPDES Permit. The effluent that was permitted to discharge to the storm drain is now being discharged to Salt Lake City's collection system, which is then treated at the Salt Lake City Water Reclamation Plant. At this time, a UPDES permit is no longer necessary because there is no direct discharge to waters of the State. Therefore, it is the intent of DWQ to terminate the UPDES permit at the end of this public comment period.
